## **THE SPAULDING BRAIN MUSIC WORKSHOP**

### **HAVE YOU HAD A STROKE? DO YOU LIKE MUSIC?**

The **Spaulding Stroke Research and Recovery Institute** will host a new opportunity for stroke survivors to make music together with the guidance of music therapists, occupational and speech therapists, and professional musicians. Participants will have the opportunity to practice motor skills with their affected arm while having fun making music with other stroke survivors.

This program will run from March through May 2018 with weekly meetings to create and play music on drums, xylophone, chimes, or bring your own instrument to play. At the end of the program we will gather to play as a group for family and friends. The group will be led by **Brian Harris** with keyboard accompaniment by **Todd Gordon**. A variety of guest musicians will engage the group with melody and improvisation during the sessions. You will make new friends, have fun making music, and practice your motor skills. You do not need to be able to read music to participate and no prior music experience is necessary.

**This program is open to anyone who has had a stroke and is well enough to participate in a group activity for two hours at a time.**
