Common Conditions we Treat:

- Chemotherapy-induced peripheral neuropathy
- Lymphedema
- Back pain from cancer, metastases or prior treatment for cancer
- Arm, leg or joint pain from cancer, metastases or prior treatment for cancer
- Neck or shoulder pain
- Deconditioning, weakness and fatigue
- Nerve dysfunction

Occupational Therapy

Occupational Therapy is a critical member of the interprofessional cancer care team.

- help for people with cancer-related impairments improve their quality of life by facilitating engagement in meaningful daily activities
- holistic and creative solutions to improve the individual's overall physical and cognitive function in order to achieve their desired goals



Speech-Language Therapy

- Speech-language therapy incorporates evaluation and treatment for spoken, written and cognitive aspects of communication in addition to swallow deficits that may result from cancer or cancer treatments.
- Goals will be based on individual, functional needs to support you in your daily life
- Therapy sessions combine education and training for skills and compensatory strategies to improve functioning within all settings (home, work, community, etc.)

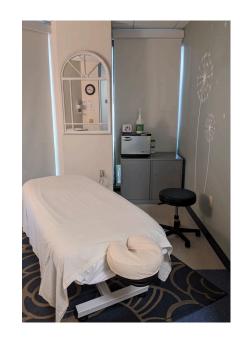
Common conditions resulting from cancer or treatment:

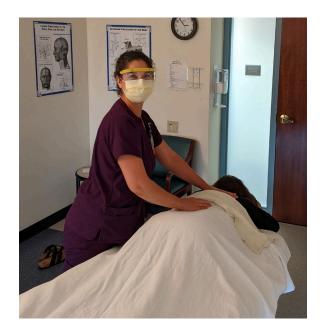
- Cognitive difficulty/
