- If your insurance requires **co-payments**, they are due at the time of each visit. We accept checks and credit card payments. Co-payments must be paid on the date of service and can be done either before or after your appointment.
- Please alert us and call the **Patient Service Center at 844-805-0205** if your **insurance changes** during your course of treatment.

24 Hour Cancellation Policy:

It is important for your care to attend all appointments. Each treatment builds upon a previous one. Please provide at least **24 hour notice for cancellations**. Also, be aware that multiple cancellations can affect your insurance coverage, and may result in discharge from our services. If you need to cancel, please call **617-952-6990**.

• **Parking:** Parking is free and available in the parking lot around the building. We are also accessible by public transportation.

What you need to bring to your visit:

- Picture identification.
- Regulation Bathing suit. No t-shirts, jean shorts or cutoffs are allowed in the pool.
- Towel
- Water shoes or sandals are recommended as the pool deck may be wet and slippery
- Change of clothes

Rules and Requirements

- When you arrive for your appointment, you must first check in with the front desk At the YMCA. Pease bring Photo ID as you may be required it to show it. Inform the YMCA Staff you have an appointment with Spaulding Quincy Aquatic Therapy.
- Please go to the locker rooms located down the corridor on the first floor to the LEFT past the
 pool area and change into your swimming suit. If you require assistance to get changed and
 ready for the pool you must provide your own aide. 2 changing rooms have a large table if you
 need it to get ready.
- Please arrive with enough time to check in, change in the locker room, and shower prior to your appointment time.
- Your initial visit will be approximately 45 minutes.
- You may use the lockers in the YMCA, but you will be required to provide your own lock. Please
 do not bring any valuables as neither the YMCA nor Spaulding is responsible for any items lost
 or stolen. Locks must be removed at the end of the session as you are not allowed to store any
 items overnight.
- Please take a shower prior to entering the pool area.
- Once you have changed, please meet your PT at the pool deck.
- Under no circumstances you will be allowed to enter the pool without the supervision of your PT. Please remind your PT of your medical history, including heart problems, diabetes or seizure disorders.
- There are 2 pools in the pool area; your therapist will let you know which one of them will be used during your session.
- A lifeguard is present at all times at the pool and emergency protocols are in place.
- You <u>may not</u> remain in the pool after your treatment session, unless you are a YMCA member and are participating in lap swim or another aquatic class.
- You may not participate in Aquatic therapy if you have any of the following:
 - 1. Open wounds
 - 2. Communicable diseases (cold, flu, hepatitis, etc...)
 - 3. Incontinence of bowel or bladder
 - 4. Uncontrolled orthostatic hypotension or Autonomic Dysreflexia
 - 5. Exercise induced Angina
 - 6. Combative or difficult to control behavior
 - 7. Tracheotomies until healed
 - 8. Presence of DVT (deep vein thrombosis) without anticoagulation therapy or filter
