

## Francis "Hooks" Burr, 1914-2004



A prominent Boston attorney who worked pro bono for years to improve health care and higher education, Hooks Burr was one of the founders of Spaulding's parent organization Partners HealthCare now Mass General Brigham—and was an early Spaulding champion. An outspoken supporter of civil liberties and women's rights, Hooks earned his law degree from Harvard and inherited his nickname from

an uncle who attended the college. Before his death in 2004, at the age of 90, Hooks served as a Spaulding trustee and, with his widow, Lucy, generously supported the hospital with both lifetime and other gifts through their financial and estate plans.

Our icon for The Hooks Burr Society incorporates an image of a burr, which is a seed pod or "hooked seed." Like a botanical hitchhiker, the burr attaches itself to a host, traveling over distances to ultimately find the perfect place to establish itself and grow. Aside from the obvious linguistic connection to Francis Burr and his nickname, the burr is a fitting analogy for a planned gift—a seed of funding that travels over time to blossom into a vital resource.
